A great opportunity is opened to us in in a Gypsy school located in Garcini. Dalila went last month to visit the School and see what kind of help we can offer to them. She met the Director and some teachers from the School, visiting the children in their classes and

A total of 800 children attend this school every day, ranging from kindergarten to high school. We expect to offer 700 Christmas gifts, including to the school of Zizin. (Every present intends to contain: Candies, a drink, notebook, pencil, a scarf, toothbrush and a small toy)
